ENGAGE ongoing works...

The progress realised are:

- Setting up local working groups in each partner country.
- Conducting desk and field researches targeted to the training needs analysis.
- Defining a curriculum and training framework.
- Designing prototype integration tools and resources.

In the six EU countries of ENGAGE we realised these activities with the participation of the final beneficiaries, the migrant women, among the staff and the would-be integration leaders.

For the identification of the would-be integration leaders, several meetings were realised with the local groups members for investigating about the appropriateness of the Curriculum framework.

This was a good stimulus to deepen the core topics considered most important by them, in order to better cope with the complex process of integration in a new country and culture.

In Vienna (AT), on 17-18 of April 2018, was held the second consortium meeting establishing:

- The sign-off the curriculum frame.
- The learning manual structure for breaking down the 6 identified learning units.
- The format and contents of the targeted OERs for Integration Leaders.
- The In-Service Transnational Training proposal for multipliers.



What ENGAGE will achieve...

1. The development of an Integration Leaders training programme for migrant women
2. The production of a digital toolbox of integration training resources
3. The design and implementation of in-service training for adult education and migrant support workers
4. A bespoke e-learning portal
5. A policy paper that highlights the learning of the ENGAGE project consortium

Some inputs...

Through our field-activities we have engaged 39 people in Local Working Groups, and 6 areas of core topics were selected for our Curriculum proposal:

1. Interpersonal skills
2. Assertive communication
3. Values and cultural identity
4. Community empowerment
5. Civic engagement
6. Leadership skills
