ENGAGE ongoing works...

The progress realised is the following:

- The 6 training modules of the Curriculum for Integration Leaders are now collected in the Learning Manual containing, beyond the learning outcomes with the breakdown in knowledge, skills and responsibility / autonomy, all useful instructions for trainers to deliver the face-to-face sessions and to guide migrant women in the self-directed learning.
- The Open Educational Resources were developed and translated into the partners' languages and soon will be available on the online Toolkit.
- The In-Service-Training programme was developed and tested among the partners' staff in Marseilles, through a joint training activity.
- The design and the structure of the educational online resources, the e-learning platform and the Toolkit, were realised for fostering our training programme for "Migrant Women as Integration Leaders".

The third partnership meeting was held in Rijeka (HR), on 30-31 of August 2018, establishing:

- The signing of the Learning Manual.
- The translation and the first testing of the Open Educational Resources.
- The planning of the In-Service Transnational Training, that was just realised in November in Marseille.
- The design outline of the e-Learning Platform.



What ENGAGE will achieve...

1. The development of an Integration Leaders training programme for migrant women
2. The production of a digital toolbox of integration -training resources
3. The design and implementation of in-service training for adult education and migrant support workers
4. A bespoke e-learning portal
5. A policy paper that highlights the learning of the ENGAGE project consortium

Some inputs...

The Joint Training Activity held in Marseilles on 19/23 of November '18, with adult educators and migrants' supporters, aimed at gaining the following learning outcomes:

- Improve skills and competences of planning and developing an in-service training programme
- Develop the skills for becoming and integration leader responsible for coordinating, planning, problem solving and implementing all requirements to achieve integration for themselves and for the other migrants.
- Develop and strengthen general didactic skills in adult education and with a special target group.
- Develop and strengthen general personal and transferable skills in adult education with a special target group.



Coming next...



- Implementation and publication of the Open Educational Resources.
- In-Service-Training piloting with adult trainers for supporting migrant women integration.
- Final testing of the Curriculum and the OERs with local groups of migrant women.
